Mason is the author of the bill of rights of Virginia which later became the American Bill of rights was added as the first ten amendments to the U.S. Constitution. There is some evidence that George Mason was also a Mason but this is not certain. Extending South-West to the Potomac new Hampshire Avenue passing through the two left vertices of the pentagram, passes through the southern part of the island Mason. The headquarters of the Masonic Scottish Rites of 33 degrees is a little below the point where new Hampshire Avenue crosses 16th street leading to the North from the White house. Shown at left is Massachusetts and Connecticut Avenue coming from the upper left circle, Rhode Island Avenue and Vermont coming from the upper right circle and a horizontal street street K form a pentagram at the top of which is the White house. The figure to the right of the Massachusetts Avenue and 19th street outbound from the upper left circle, Rhode island Avenue and 13th street coming from the upper right circle, new York Avenue and 19th street from the lower left square and Pennsylvania Avenue and 13th street from the lower right of the square form a hexagram. in which the White house is located at the bottom

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
